To Start:

- 3. Let's make a list of everything we learn about "those who believe" and another list of "those who do not believe" from verses 6 to 8; At the end let's compare both lists.



4. - What does God expect from his church and why? Let's read verses 9 and 10, and talk.

For Reflection:

- 1. Have you experienced significant spiritual growth in the last year? what could you attribute the fact that yes or that you have not experienced it?
- 2. How can you contribute so that as a church we all do evangelism? do you think that's important (within God's design for his church)?
- 3. What does "the centrality of Christ" mean to you?
- 4. What virtues of Christ do you think are most noticeable in your cell and in SEMILLA in general?
