#### "Blessed"

1. - Because Jesus REIGNS in our hearts... (vs. 14b-15a)
2. - Because we live each day with HOPE..... (vs. 15b)
3. - Because we maintain a CLEAR CONSCIENCE (vs. 16)

*Objective: To know who Peter calls a blessed person..*

#### ***Icebreaker:***

#### ***To Start:***

1. - Let us briefly share some of our notes and/or our reflections derived from last Sunday's teaching on "Semilla Online", 1 Peter 3:13-16.
2. - Let's review this week's memorization together and then two or three volunteers say our memory verses.

#### ***To Observe:***

1. - What answer can you give to Peter's question in verse 13? (Let's try to support our response with a verse from the Bible).
2. - What relationship do you find between verse 14 and what Jesus taught his disciples in Matthew 5: 11-12.
3. - What things characterize the disciples of Jesus called "Blessed" in verses 14 to 16? (Let's read the portion in various versions, make a list of the most interesting, and talk)
