1 Peter 5:6-14

"Let us worship God"

- 1.- Humble ourselves before him.....(vs.6)
- 2.- Taking refuge in him.....(vs. 7-9)
- 3.- Glorifying him alone....(vs. 10-11)
- 4.- Growing in him.....(vs. 12-14)

Objective: Decide to live a life that brings praise and recognition to Jesus Christ down to the smallest details.

Icebreaker:

How flexible or resistant are you to sudden changes? (Each of the participants tries to give an example when sharing)

To Start:

- 1. Let us briefly share some of our notes and/or our reflections derived from last Sunday's teaching on "Semilla Online", 1 Peter 5:6-14.
- 2. Let's review this week's memorization together and then two or three volunteers say our memory verses.

To Observe

- 1. Let's compare verses 6 and 7. What do both verses have in common? Do you find any difference between them?
- 2. What can we learn about "spiritual warfare" in verses 8 and 9? Let's watch and comment.
- 3. What role does God play in the disciple's life in light of verses 10 and 11?
- 4.- Let's read verses 12 to 14 in various versions, and then let's each of the participants take a few minutes and make our own "paraphrase" (simplified version) of the text;



At the end of the time, each participant reads their "paraphrase" to the rest of the group.

For Reflection:

- 1.- What has cost you more work in recent months and why: Acknowledge your sins before God, turn away from them, ask God for advice and direction, enjoy the meditation of his word, rest in prayer from all your anxieties, other?
- 2. What do you think was why the devil had you in his "jaws" last time? How can you prevent that from happening again?
- 3. What positive changes in your character can you attribute to the work of the Spirit of God in you? For which of them are you most grateful to God?
- 4. What does it mean for you to "be in Jesus Christ"?

Memorization:

Beginner Level: 1 Peter 5:11 To him be the power for ever and ever. Amen.

Intermediate Level: 1 Peter 5:6,7 6 Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. 7 Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.
