Objective: Bless the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ for his great mercy in making us reborn for a living hope.

Icebreaker:

What would be any reason that makes you feel proud to belong to your family?

To Start:

- 1. Let's briefly share some of our notes and/or our reflections derived from Sunday's teaching in "Semilla Online", 1 Peter 1: 3-12.
- 2. Let's review together this week's memorization and then two or three volunteers, let's say our verses.

To Observe:

- 1. After reading verses 3 and 4 in various versions, each of the participants writes their own version of these two verses.
- 2. What can we learn in verses 5 to 7 about the tests? The facilitator makes a list of the group's observations and, at the end, reads them all together.
- 3. What relationship do you find between love and faith in verses 8 and 9?
- 4. What aspect of the ministry of the prophets is most interesting to you? Let's read verses 10 to 13 to talk and learn from each other.



For Reflection:

- 1. What does the fact that Jesus rose from the dead mean to you?
- 2. What specific benefits have you received from any of the affiliations you have been through lately?
- 3. If love for God is expressed in faith and trust, how much would you say you love God?
- 4. How many blessings can you currently count because of the sufferings of Christ?
