"Obedience"

- 1. Returns God to the throne of our heart (vs. 18-21)
- 2. Purifies our soul (vs. 22)
- 3. Is fertile ground for the word of God (vs. 23-25)

Objective: Become more and more obedient disciples..

Icebreaker:

Are you one who read the instructions (manual) before launching a device or putting together a piece of furniture? Why or why not?

To Start:

- 1. Let's briefly share some of our notes and / or our reflections derived from last Sunday's teaching in "Semilla Online", 1 Peter 1: 18-25.
- 2. Let's review together this week's memorization and then two or three volunteers say our memory verses.

To Observe:

- 1. What can we learn about Jesus Christ from verses 18 to 22? Let's watch and make a list while the moderator takes notes and shares it with us at the end.
- 2. Let's read verse 22 in several versions, and then take 5 minutes for each of the participants to make our own version, understandable for a 5-year-old child.
- 3. How many contrasts can we observe in verses 23 to 25? Let's read the verses and talk.



For Reflection:

- 1. Do you think you have more faith than obedience? How could you grow in both with God?
- 2. What could be one of the great "pending subjects" for which you simply lack more obedience?
- 3. What things in your life are dying (like grass), and the word of God could give it life? Is it up to you to do something about it?

Memorization:

1 Peter 1:18-25 New International Version

¹⁸ For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, ¹⁹ but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect. ²⁰ He was chosen before the creation of the world, but was revealed in these last times for your sake. ²¹ Through him you believe in God, who raised him from the dead and glorified him, and so your faith and hope are in God.

²² Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for each other, love one another deeply, from the heart. ^[a] ²³ For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.

²⁴ For,

"All people are like grass,

and all their glory is like the flowers of the field;

the grass withers and the flowers fall,

but the word of the Lord endures forever."
