Icebreaker:

To Start:

- 1. Let us briefly share some of our notes and/or our reflections derived from last Sunday's teaching on "Semilla Online", 2 Peter 1:1-8.
- 2. Let's review this week's memorization together and then two or three volunteers say our memory verses.

To Observe:

- 1. Let's read together in various versions, verses 1 to 2, and then, each of us mentions what most calls our attention in this introduction.
- 2. How many blessings can you count in verses 3 and 4? Is there one of them on which all the others depend?
- 3. What does Peter prescribe in verses 5 to 8? Let's read the text in various versions and then make our own paraphrase (explanation in our own words)... at the end, each read and briefly explains their composition.



To Reflect:

- 1. Where do you think you are in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ: In the same place where you were a year ago, two or three?... In a different place at the time of your conversion? Do you think you know him more or less? Other?
- 2. When the Bible tells you everything you need to face life's challenges to please God, you already have: Does it make you happy, frustrates you, intrigues you, encourage you, another?
- 3. In which of the 7 virtues listed by Pedro do you need to work more? Which of them have you been growing in you in the last few weeks?
