1. - Let's read together in various versions, verses 1 to 2, and then, each of us mentions what most calls our attention in this introduction.
2. - How many blessings can you count in verses 3 and 4? Is there one of them on which all the others depend?
3. - What does Peter prescribe in verses 5 to 8? Let's read the text in various versions and then make our own paraphrase (explanation in our own words)... at the end, each read and briefly explains their composition.

### **To Reflect:**

1. - Where do you think you are in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ: In the same place where you were a year ago, two or three?... In a different place at the time of your conversion? Do you think you know him more or less? Other?
2. - When the Bible tells you everything you need to face life's challenges to please God, you already have: Does it make you happy, frustrates you, intrigues you, encourage you, another?
3. - In which of the 7 virtues listed by Pedro do you need to work more? Which of them have you been growing in you in the last few weeks?
