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| 1 You can recognize them (vs. 1-2) |
| 2 You can avoid them (vs. 3) |
| 3 You can fight them (vs. 4-10a.) |
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Objective: Learn to recognize false teachers.

Icebreaker:

Do you recall any teacher you could deem "dangerous" during your schooling??

To Start:

1. - Let's review this week's memorization together (2 Peter 1:19-21), and then two or three volunteers say our memory verses. (Let's try to match it with the one from the previous week)

2. - Let us briefly share some of our notes and/or our reflections derived from last Sunday's teaching in "Semilla Online" (2 Peter 2:1-10a.)

To Observe:

1. - Let's read the first 2 verses and then make a list of everything we can learn about false teachers and their teaching. The moderator takes notes and reads them to the group.

2. - Let's read verse 3 to comment: What relationship do you find between wanting to "market" to believers with the use of "pretend words" (plastic) that false teachers use?

3. - Let's read verses 4 to 10 to comment. What would be (from your perspective) the "central thought" that runs through these verses?

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To Reflect:

1. - Have you come across a "false teacher"? How did you recognize it?

2.- Are you one of those who want to fill their mold with some type of teaching that encourages them, or one of those who let yourself be shaped in your reading and study of the word of God?

3. - How can a person show the Lordship of Jesus in their lives? How do you do it?
