"Christianity without Christ"

- 1.- It is to be formed on the Wrong "line"..... (vs. 9-11)
- 2.- It is to experience a progressive deterioration....(vs. 12-13)
- 3.- Is to create my own character.....(vs. 14-16)
- 4.- It is to write "my own Bible".....(vs. 17-19)
- 5.- It is very unfortunate.....(vs. 20-22)

Objective: *Ask ourselves if this tragedy could happen to us and take the appropriate measures.*

Icebreaker:

Have you suffered from an illness that has brought you "to the brink" of death??

To Start:

1. - Let's review this week's memorization together (2 Peter 2:1,2), and then two or three volunteers say our memory verses.
2. - Let us briefly share some of our notes and/or our reflections derived from last Sunday's teaching in "Semilla Online" (2 Peter 2:9-22)

To Observe:

1. - If you had to summarize the attitude of these false teachers with a single word, what would it be? Let's read only verses 9-11 to choose our word and share it with the group.
2. - What would you say is the main symptom with which these false teachers manifest their gradual deterioration? Let's talk after reading together verses 12 and 13.
3. - According to verses 14 to 16, what could be the motive behind everything these false teachers teach?

4. - What aspects of "the doctrine" of these false teachers stand out in verses 17 to 19?
5. - How do these false teachers begin and how do they end according to verses 20 to 22?

To Reflect:

1. - What feeling do you have when you think of the glorious return of the Lord: Fear, joy, doubt, don't you think about that, someone else?
2. - Have you experienced any change in your way of living as a Christian? Would you say it is a positive or negative change?
3. - What do you usually do to ensure that your reasons for serving are genuine?
4. - Judging by the effect of your teaching on the people you influence (relatives, cell, seed, etc.) would you say that what you teach them is the Bible or your own moral code of conduct?
5. - What can you do this week to "not get entangled" again with the contaminations of the world?

Memorization: Review all verses of 2 Peter

2 Peter 1:5-8 NIV

For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; ⁶ and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; ⁷ and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affection, love. ⁸ For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Peter 1:9-11 NIV

But whoever does not have them is nearsighted and blind, forgetting that they have been cleansed from their past sins. ¹⁰ Therefore, my brothers and sisters, ^[a] make every effort to confirm your calling and election. For if you do these things, you will never stumble, ¹¹ and you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

2 Peter 1:19-21 NIV

We also have the prophetic message as something completely reliable, and you will do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts. ²⁰ Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation of things. ²¹ For prophecy never had its origin in the human will, but prophets, though human, spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

2 Peter 2:1-2 NIV

But there were also false prophets among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you. They will secretly introduce destructive heresies, even denying the sovereign Lord who bought them—bringing swift destruction on themselves. ² Many will follow their depraved conduct and will bring the way of truth into disrepute.
