Objective: "To know that even through Esau's genealogy the heart of God is revealed, that all human beings are given the opportunity to know him."

Ice Breaker

1. If you could choose between living where you want, marrying who you want or winning what you want, which of would you choose from the three?

To Observe In The Text:

1. What do VV.1 to 5 tell us about Esau's attitude towards his father's desire for marriage? (Also let's read Genesis 28:1)
2. Jacob took his children out of the promised land and then went to live in it, what did Esau do? Let's read verses 6 through 8.
3. Let's read verses 9 to 30 one by one to know, the town, the leaders and the place (with its inhabitants) that Esau and his family arrived to.
4. What particularity can we notice from Edom and how they are governed their people? Let's read verses 31 to 39 and talk.
5. Jacob's story would be incomplete without the story of Esau. Even in spite of Esau's desire not to be part of the people of God, God makes it clear in this story that his heart never was to throw it away bless him Let's look at verses 40 through 37:1 to talk about this principle.

To Apply / Reflect On

1. In what ways does your marriage (or the marriage of your parents if you're single) honor God? ... In what way did the decisions you made last week anticipate the blessing of God?
2. Which of God's blessings this week have left you more open-mouthed about the grace and mercy of God?
3. Take a moment to think about someone who is far from God? How can we pray for them and reach out to them this week?
