Objective: To take Joseph as an example to follow, of what to do when adversity comes.

Icebreaker:

1. Has a dream ever helped you understand something that happened in the past? **Context Question:** In V.1 we read, "Some time later..." can someone in the group remind us what happened prior to this phrase?

To Observe In the Bible:

- 1. After reading **VV.1-6**, what was Joseph's first "relationship" with the chief cupbearer and the chief baker?
- 2. Read **VV.6-19**; Without getting so caught up with the details of the dreams, how did Joseph gain the trust of the two officials, so that they shared their dreams with him?
- 3. Why do you think the outcome of the two officials were different from one another? Look at **VV**. **20-21**
- 4. What alternative ending would you give to this chapter to replace **V. 23**?

Application Questions:

- 1. Joseph clung to his vocation, God being with him and prospering him, what is your vocation as a believer?
 - a. What are the things that make up our identity as disciples of Jesus? **

 Think together and share some scriptures particularly from the Gospels that speak to us of our identity and vocation as disciples of Jesus.**
- 2. In the last couple of days have you had a fresh revelation of the Grace of God?
 - a. What relationship did this have with the service to others? (The Moderator explains the question

- 3. Is there a circumstance in your life right now that you don't understand? Do you think that circumstance is making your trust in Jesus stronger or weaker?
- 4. What role has CREWS (Crew Members) played in strengthening your faith?
 - a. What role can you play, to help those in your CREW strengthen their walk with Jesus?
