Questions To Start:

Questions In TheText:

1. Read VV.1-7 to discuss some highlights/questions in the text.
2. What are some of the things God does and gives in V.1, before the people respond in obedience rooted in love?
3. Have you ever felt frustrated because you tried pleasing Him or impress Him, without considering that our relationship with God is a response to all He's done for us?
4. Let's make a list of how the Israelites gave and worked to build the tabernacle.
5. Take a moment and compare how these people served God and how we today serve God. After a couple minutes of honest reflection share with the group your compare and contrast.
6. What about God's love for you impresses you the most? What passage in the Bible comes to mind in regards to God's love for you?
