EXODUS 17

Objective: *To discover the type of people God uses to reach the world.*

Ice Breaker:

1. Are there any problems you are facing today that could be fixed by complaining?
2. For the Kids: Pick 2 volunteers in the CREW, see which one of the two can keep their hands up in the air the longest. (Moderator prepare a little gift for the winner)

Observation & Application Questions

1. **Observation:** Read VV.1-2: Into which circumstance does God lead his people? What are the differences between the attitude of the Isrealites and Moses?
 - a. **Application:** How does it make you feel knowing that life at times will NOT go as you expected them too? (Moderator give an example) Have you ever tried to manipulate God by giving him orders, or maybe by throwing a tantrum...etc?
2. **Observation:** After reading VV.3-4; What's the first thing Moses does when things start getting out of control?
 - a. **Application:** When it comes to your personal decisions in life, How important is it to you what God thinks about them? What steps / process do you go through before making life changing decision?
3. **Observation:** Read VV.5-8; How important do you think the elders were for God, in the process of giving the people water from a rock through Moses?
 - a. **Application:** Who are the "elders" you've surrounded yourself with, those who you ask for advice and give accountability too? (moderators reinforce the importance of having "elders" in their lives)
4. **Observation:** In light of VV.8-10; how does Moses react to the Amalekites declaring war against them?

- a. **Application:** Has God recently shown you a need in your home, your church, your community...other? How do you plan on responding to this need?
- 5. **Observation:** Finally read VV.11-16; How does Moses make himself visible to the people? (Moderator share all 3 possible interpretations to this text)
 - a. **Application:** In your opinion, is it easier to give orders verbally or set an example? How do you think this next generation can be inspired to follow Jesus?
