**Observation / Application Questions:**

1. **Observation:** Read VV.1-6; Let's take a closer look at Moses's family, how close do you think Moses was to his wife and children? How do his children's names speak of what Moses has been through so far?
  - a. **Application:** In regards to your family: How important are they to you? Are there some things that need to change in your priorities? How do you think God wants to use you in your family?
2. **Observation:** Let's read VV.7-12; Do you think that the way Moses treated Jethro ,with love and respect, opened the door for Moses to share his story and his faith with him?
  - a. **Application:** Who in your sphere of influence (School, work, family...other) needs to hear you story and your faith?
3. **Observation:** Read VV.13-27; What did Jethro observe Moses doing? What was his advice for him? Which aspect of this advice catches your attention the most? How does Moses respond?
  - a. **Application:** How did you respond the last time someone God's placed over you (Pastor, Leader, Boss, Parents) called you out on something?
  - b. Which one of the qualities in V.21 do you need to work on the most?
