## SEMILLA CELL GROUP EXODUS 35 Q'S

**Introduction**: In light of the pandemic, as Jesus followers we need to re-evaluate the way, reason we pray. This week we will reflect on how to pray differently. - 3. Everyone write down a short prayer of faith and trust in God, share it with the group once you're done.
- 4. What did God expect from his people in V.5?
- 5. How did the people of God respond from VV.21-29?
- 6. Why do you think this passage emphasizes on the willingness of the people giving generously. What does 2 Corinthians 9:7 say?
- 7. Which of the gifts/talents that God has given you, do you think you need to use more for the work of God?

- 8. When you give, do you do it because you feel obligated to give, or because it comes from a willing and joyful heart?
- 9. What should be the prayer of a generous person?
