Questions in the text:

1. In which passages of the Bible do we find the following

 - b. His proximity to the suffering and pain the people felt
2. How do these remind us of Jesus?
3. How do we see God's mercy on Pharaoh during the 10th plague?
4. When do the people receive the 10 commandments, and what does this have to do with the Gospel message? (Hint: think of the timeline)
5. What broke and infuriated God in chapter 32 when the people built a golden calf to worship him? How does Jesus deal with this during his ministry here on earth?
6. To which "theme" does the book of Exodus give the most attention to, what context does this theme have to do with the rest of the Bible ?
7. What about the book of Exodus has impacted your life the most?
