Objective: To understand the third commandment, by looking at it from different angles, and applying it to our life.

- 2. To whom do you feel closest too? Your mom or your dad?

To Observe / Apply

- 1. What does this commandment reveal about God's character and attributes?
- 2. In a patriarchal culture, like the Jewish one, why do you think God decides to be represented through the family (both father and mother)? What implications could this mean for us?
- 3. What reason does V.12 give us to honor our parents? How does Paul emphasize this in Ephesians 6:2-3?
 - a. What does it mean to you when it says, "Honor your parents so that your days may be long?"
- 4. How do you think that a child, teenager, young adult, adults can honor their parents?
 - a. What does our culture say about honoring our parents?
- 5. How do you honor your parents?
 - a. How do you think you can honor them this week?
