Objective: <u>To understand the third commandment</u>, by looking at it from different angles, and applying it to our life.

Ice Breaker: (Introduce everyone in the conversation)

- 1. When you get mad are you the type of person that let's go of it quickly?
- 2. Which of the following things gets you mad the most?
 - a. When someone eats a snack you bought.
 - b. When someone dirties something you just cleaned.
 - c. When you're talking to someone and they ignore you.
 - d. When you're talking and someone interrupts you.
 - e. When someone takes your iPhone charger without asking.

Memory Verse Activity:

 Spin a bottle, whoever it lands on starts with V.1, go to the right and everyone say a verse. (If you miss 3 verses you're out.) Come up with a punishment for loser together.

Observation / Application Questions:

- 1. What about God's character is revealed in commandment #6?
- 2. Read: John 1:1-4, John 14:6 and John 11:25 // What does life have to do with the person of Jesus?
 - a. In light of these verses, when we break commandment #6 against who are we sinning? (Compare all responses to Ezekiel 18:4)
- 3. What does James 4:1-4 and Matthew 5:17-20 say about murder?
- 4. Let's read the words of Jesus on the 6th commandment in Matthew 5:21-24 and talk about what catches your attention the most.
- 5. Finally, Take a moment to ask God to reveal to you if there is any resentment towards anyone or if anyone has resentment towards you.

 a. What does Jesus say about this commandment in Matthew 5:23-25? (The Moderator take a couple of minutes to explain what the Bible teaches about conflicts and how to approach them based off Matthew 18:15-20)
