**Objective:** Consider if we are in danger of drifting away from the faith, the invitation is to consider what great salvation we've received.

**Icebreaker:**

1. What is the most recent memory you have about the water?

**Question to start:**

**Questions to observe in the text:**

1. Read the first 4 verses; What warning does this passage give us?
2. How would you describe the grace of God after reading VV.5-9?
3. In light of VV.10-13; What joy does the believer experience in Christ?
4. What are some of the effects from Jesus's death mentioned here in VV.14-15?
5. What do VV.16-18 say about the help Jesus gives us?

**Questions to reflect on:**

1. Have you ever drifted away from your relationship with God? Where do you stand today?
2. How would you describe God's love for you?
3. How could you enjoy your relationship with God more?
4. What does it mean to you, to not be afraid of death?

**Pray:** What do you need God to help you with today? The Bible tells us that Jesus is our helper. (Take a moment and pray for each other)

**Verse to memorize: Hebrews 2:9** | *But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.*
