- 1) To Our Spiritual Void (vs 18-19)
- 2) To All Our Questions (v 20)
- 3) To Our Prayers (v 21-22)

Objective: *To enliven our prayer life, without religious masks or fig leaves that prevent us from doing so.*

Icebreaker: What food is your "secret weapon" when hunger strikes you and you're away from home?

To Start:

1. Let's review the memory verse Isaiah 56:7
2. Let's briefly share some of our notes and/or our reflections derived from this weekend's teaching on Matthew 2:18-22

To Observe a little and think a little:

1. What relationship do you find between verses 18 and 19 with the previous story?
Let's read both passages and share.

2. What was it that amazed the disciples in verse 20 and why do you think this was so?
3. Let's list everything we can learn about prayer in verses 21 and 22.

To Reflect:

1. Is there a "fig tree" that you have put your trust in that needs to be dried up so that your faith and trust can be in Jesus and his word?
2. What commands of God's word have you disobeyed by thinking that you have a "better opinion"?
3. Let's take time as a cell to pray for our young people, for marriages, and for those to whom we will have the opportunity to share the gospel during the month of March.
