## To Observe a little and think a little:

1. Let's read together in the version of our preference verses 33 to 41 so that each of us can comment on what catches our attention most in this parable.

2. Let's now make a list of everything we can learn about Jesus (the son), from verses 42 to 44. 3. Reading the audience's reaction in verses 45 and 46, would you say that Jesus is a good teacher? For what reason? To reflect: 1. Psalm 146 offers us an interesting picture of the kingdom of God; Let's read it and imagine for a moment those fruits of the kingdom happening around us. 2. As a Church (Semilla), what do you think we should do to produce this kind of fruit? 3. Let's take a moment to pray for this to happen. Let's Pray.
