Icebreaker: What would you say is the most important thing your parents taught you at home?

To Start:

- 1. Let's review together the memory verse Matthew 22:29, and then, some of us can recite it by heart.
- 2. Let's briefly share something from our notes and/or reflections derived from this weekend's teaching in Matthew 22:34-46.

To Observe a bit and think a bit:

- 1. After reading verses 34 to 40 in a couple of versions, let's discuss, Why do you think Jesus responded in this way to that interpreter of the law?
- 2. What could we learn from Jesus' style when conversing with unbelievers? Let's read verses 41 to 46.

3. How would you answer the question Jesus asks in verse 45? Let's read and discuss it
To Reflect:
1. Are you someone who explains complicated things in a simple way, or someone who complicates even the simplest things to explain?
2. What's the most important thing you've read in the Bible?
3. How did you respond to it? (to the most important thing you've read)
4. Is the great commandment for you, a great burden or great promise? Why?

Verses to Memorize: Matthew 22:37-39 "Jesus said to him, 'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself."
