**"The Christian Life"**

- 1) Jesus arrives on time (vs. 22-27)
- 2) Jesus reveals Himself through trials (vs.28-33)
- 3) Jesus strengthens our faith (vs. 34-36)

**Objective: Reflect on the great contrasts that a disciple of Jesus lives in his faith.**

Icebreaker: What types of experiences have you been able to learn more from: your successes or your failures? Could you give an example?

**To Start:**

1. Let's review our memory verses Matthew 14:16-18
  
2. Let us briefly share some of our notes and/or our reflections derived from the teaching this weekend in Matthew 14:22-36.

**To Observe a little and think a little:**

1. Let's read verses 22 and 23 and comment, what calls our attention in this scene?

2. Judging from verses 24 to 27, would you say that the disciples were brave people or fearful; people who walked by faith or by sight alone?
3. Let's make a couple of lists as we read verses 28 to 31: one of the positive things and other of the negative things that we find in Peter
4. What distinguishes a disciple of Jesus according to verse 33?
5. What relationship do you find between verses 34 to 36 and the previous verses?

**To Reflect:**

1. How does it make you feel that, beyond your mistakes or your virtues, Jesus intercede for you?
2. When it comes to your faith, do you consider yourself more courageous or fearful?
3. Are there any character traits in Peter that you would like to imitate and/or any that you should avoid?
4. Under what circumstances is your worship of God more real, more sincere...perhaps even more expressive?
