<i>Expository Outline</i>	"Sardis, the ALMOST CHRISTIAN church

Objective: To keep in mind, retain and obey the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Icebreaker:

1. - If you could take a vacation right now, anywhere in the world, where would you like to go?

To start:

1. - Let's take a few minutes to go over the memorization of the verse from the previous week (2:25), and also to practice the verses that we have memorized during the Revelation series.
2. - Each of the participants shares some of their notes from Sunday's teaching. (The intention is to develop disciples with a habit of taking notes during teachings).

To Observe:

1. - Someone in the group read verses 1 to 6 carefully and with intonation. After listening carefully, let's talk about what stands out the most in this letter.
2. - What is Jesus' diagnosis for the church in Sardis? Let's make a list of everything the text tells us, both by declaration and by implication its spiritual state. (The moderator takes note and at the end reads the group's observations)
3. - What are the precise instructions of Jesus for this church?
4. - What relationship can there be between not staining our clothes and Jesus confessing our name before the Father? (Let's talk about what Matthew 10:32 and 1 John 4:15 say)

To Reflect:

1. - What would you do if Jesus said to you directly: "You have a reputation of being a Christian but you are really dead."
2. - What would be some of the works that you need to complete? (The moderator explains the role works play in the life of the disciple of Jesus Christ)
3. - What could we do to keep the word of God present in our minds and our hearts every day? What difference could this make for us?
4. - How would you like your actions to make Christ more visible this week? (Let's put these petitions before God in prayer)

Let's have a time of prayer.

Verse to memorize:

Revelation 3:2 Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have found your deeds unfinished in the sight of my God. (NIV)
