Expository Outline

"Laodicea, the POOR church

1. - Revelation (vs 14)
2. - Rebuke (15-17)
3. - Warning (18-19)
4. - Promise (20-22)

Objective: To consider the greatness of God's grace, in light of both his rebuke and of his promise to Laodicea.

Icebreaker:

1. - If you could invite anyone to your house for dinner, who would you invite and why?

To start:

1. - Let's take a few minutes to practice memorizing last week's verse (Revelation 3: 8).
 2. - Each of the participants share something from their notes from Sunday's teaching.
- (The intention is to form in the disciples the habit of always taking notes during the teaching)

To Observe:

1. - What can we learn about Jesus Christ in verse 14?
2. - What is the diagnosis that "the faithful and true witness" makes of the Laodicean church in verses 15 to 17? (The moderator takes note and at the end makes a summary of what the group)
3. - In light of the advice that Jesus gives them, what can we learn about true wealth in verses 18 and 19?
4. - Which of the promises that Jesus makes to Laodicea in verses 20 to 22 calls the most attention and why?

To Reflect:

1. - What can we do to avoid being victims of self-deception?
2. - In what aspect of your life do you need to give more credit to what God says about you than what you think about yourself?
3. - What aspect of the Lord's counsel to Laodicea do you need to begin to implement this week:
 - a) Accept the difficulties of life as an opportunity to grow in your faith?
 - b) Think about the needs of others, give of your time, break bread with the needy, serve your church exercising one of your gifts, another?
 - c) See life as Jesus sees it (in light of his word)?
4. - What aspect of God's Grace can you be most grateful for today: The interruption of your plans, the confrontation of your sin, the invitation to meet him, another? (Pray for this to end our conversation)

Let's have a time of prayer.

Verse to memorize:

Revelation 3:18-20 So I counsel you to purchase gold perfected by fire, so that you can be truly rich. Purchase a white garment to cover and clothe your shameful Adam-nakedness. Purchase eye salve to be placed over your eyes so that you can truly see. ¹⁹ All those I dearly love I unmask and train. So repent and be eager to pursue what is right. ²⁰ Behold, I'm standing at the door, knocking. If your heart is open to hear my voice and you open the door within, I will come in to you and feast with you, and you will feast with me. (TPT)
