Revelation 4:1-11

"The throne of God" 1. - A throne of Glory..... (1-3) 2. - A throne of Authority. (4-7) 3. - A throne of Praise ... (8-11)

<u>Objective: Have each participant answer the question: who is God currently in my</u> <u>life, and who does he need to become?</u>

Icebreaker:

1. - Have you ever visited a palace? What caught your attention the most?

To start:

1. - Let's take a few minutes to review and/or practice Revelation 3: 18-20.

2. - What did God speak to you personally during the teaching of Revelation 4? (Let's share briefly with each other "the best of our notes")

To Observe:

1.- After making a list of everything we learn about the throne from verses 1 to 3, Let us comment: which of the characteristics or aspects of the throne attract our attention the most and why?

2. - If you had to make a drawing of the throne, based on verses 4 to 7, how would you draw it? Before we talk, let's take a few moments (in silence) to read and imagine.

3. - Let's ask the journalistic questions (what, who, where, when, how, why) to the subject of the praise in verses 8-11. The facilitator records the group's observations and then just read what you wrote down.

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To Reflect:

1. - How does the fact that God is sitting on his throne make you feel? What meaning should this have for you?

2. - What can we learn in this passage about everything that God has created such as animals, nature, etc?

3. - In what way do you think your worship of God needs to improve:

a) From occasional worship,	c) From me being the	d) From singing out of tune
to a continual worship	center of my life, to him	to singing in tune
b) To adore him for who he is, not how I feel	becoming the center of my life (wishes, dreams, decisions, etc)	e) Other
