Objective: To understand how dangerous it is for the church to have someone claim divine authority, and dare to "prophesy" vanities and things that God never said.

Icebreaker:

1. - What is the item of clothing, jewel, article, musical instrument, etc ... that has been with you the longest? Why have you kept it for so long?

To start:

- 1. Let's take a few minutes to practice memorization of last week's verse (2: 14, 15).
- 2. Each of the participants shares some of their notes from Sunday's teaching. (The intention is to develop disciples with a habit of taking notes during teachings).

To Observe:

- 1. Let's divide the letter into its 5 different sections (revelation, recognition, rebuke, warning, and promise), let's assign each section to a different participant, and read it (verses 18 to 29).
- 2. Let's compare the recognition (vs. 19) with the rebuke (vs. 20, 21). Which would you say is more extensive?
- 3. If it were not for the reprimand, and in light of its recognition, what opinion would you have of the Thyatira church and why?
- 4. Let's make a list of everything we learn about Jezebel in verses 20-23. (Moderator takes note of the group's observations and read them when they feel the list is complete)



- 5. What does Peter say about false prophets in 2 Peter 2: 1-3? Who are the targets of his deceptions according to 2 Peter 2:14?
- 6. According to the message of Jesus to his church in Thyatira, what is the way to flee from his deception? Let's read Revelation 2: 24, 25.

To Reflect:

- 1. Of the praise that Jesus has for the church of Thyatira, which one or which of them do you think could also be for SEMILLA? In which of these aspects do you think we could work on to improve as a church?
- 2. Which of these compliments could be for the people of this cell? Let's take some time to affirm and encourage one another.
- 3. When was the last time that, under the influence of another person, you were tempted to not take into account the counsel of God in his word?
- 4. Who would be "Jezebel" for you at this moment, whose advice is taking you away from your faith, trust, love, and fidelity to what God says in his word? (No need to give names)
- 5. What can we do as a cell to prevent the destructive effects of false teaching?
