Objective: React in a personal way to the reality and great truth presented in this chapter: The Lamb is God.

Icebreaker:

1. - What is the best concert or musical show in which you have participated or been present? What made it so special?

To Start:

1. - Let's find a couple of volunteers to say the memory verse from last week, Revelation 4:11.
2. - Let's take a few minutes to share the best of our teaching notes at Semilla Virtual, from Revelation 5.

To Observe:

"Remember that our observation and reflection questions are built around the expository outline".

1. - Let's read verses 1 to 4 in several versions, and then, each one in his words, try to express "the dilemma" described there. (Let's just talk about those 4 verses and avoid preaching to each other)
2. - How would you reconcile what John heard with what John saw in verses 5 and 6?

3. - Let's make a thematic list of everything we learn about worship from verses 7 to 10. (The moderator takes note of the group's observations and comments to read them once the list is made)

4. - What is the reason why the thousands of Angels around the throne praise the Lamb? Let's read and discuss verses 11 through 14.

To Reflect:

1. - What do you think is the dilemma of humanity and how do you think the Lamb is capable of fixing it?

2.- Let's take a few minutes for each of us to write a verse, a poem, a song or a thought, inspired by the praise the Lamb receives in this chapter.

3.- What aspect of the revelation of Jesus in this chapter do you think you need to consider better or reflect more, in this moment of your life? The Lamb, The Lion, both, why? Let's have a time of prayer.

Revelation 5:5,6

Then one of the elders said to me, "Stop weeping. Look! The mighty Lion of Judah's tribe, the root of David—he has conquered! He is the worthy one who can open the scroll and its seven seals."
