<i>Expository Outline</i>	"The tragedy of man"
	1. - Experienced a catastrophe (1-8)
	2. - Had a chance.... (9-11)
	3. - And wasted it (12-17)

Objective: To identify, which of the characters in the cast or "casting" presented in this chapter best represents us.

Icebreaker:

1. - Do you have any experience riding a horse, walking one, being the owner of one, other? What do you remember most about that experience?

To Start:

- 1. - Let's take a few minutes to practice Revelation 5: 5 and then some of the volunteers say it by heart.
- 2. - Let's take a few minutes to share with each other some of our teaching notes From last Sunday.

To Observe:

- 1. - Let's read verses 1 to 8 to comment:
 - a) What are the similarities that you find in these first 4 seals?
 - b) After reading them do you feel that they are in any way related to each other? In what way?

2. - In what state do the disciples of Jesus Christ find themselves in verses 9 to 11?

3. - Who are they and in what way are those who appear on the sixth seal affected? Let's read and comment on verses 12 to 17. (Remember that a closer and more detailed observation, Will take us to a better interpretation)

To Reflect:

1. - Which of the six seals makes the biggest impression on you and why?

2.- In the midst of life's catastrophes, are you one of those who hide from God or those who find refuge in Him? (Let's take a few minutes to share with each other from our own experience)

3.- In what way could God use you individually and / or this cell as a team, to create chaos in this materialistic world, violent and separated from the truth? (The moderator narrate briefly the story around the accusation launched by those from Thessalonica: "... those who upset the entire world have come here too "(Acts 17: 6b.)
