"The Family of God - Part Two"

1. What is most valuable in the Family of God? (verses 10-11)
2. What is the Danger that Jesus warns us about? (verse 12)
3. How can we measure success in the Family of God? (verses 13-14)

Objective: Reflect on the need to take care of each other.

Icebreaker: Have you ever recovered a very valuable object that had been lost for a long time?

To Start:

1. Let's review our memory verses Matthew 18:2-3
2. Let us briefly share some of our notes and/or our reflections derived from the teaching this weekend in Matthew 18:10-14

To Observe a little and think a little:

1. How valuable is a "little one" who has believed in Jesus? Let's read verses 10 and 11 in a few versions and share.

2. What differences do you find between the parable of the lost sheep told by Matthew and the one told in Luke? Let's read verses 12-13 and Luke 15:1-7 to discuss (the moderator take note of the group's observations)
3. What is Jesus' heart toward those who have believed according to verse 14? Let's read it before sharing.

To Reflect:

1. In how many ways can a Christian show indifference and/or contempt for another christian?
2. What answer do you think Jesus would like to hear from you when he asks you about a lost brother?
3. What do we need to do as cells to recover, to find those little sheep that are lost or deceived?
