"The Servant of God"

- 1.- His identity (15-18)
- 2.- His style (19-20)
- 3.- His mission (21)

Objective: Find an example to follow in Matthew's description of the servant of God.

Icebreaker: Who was the person, character, artist, etc... that inspired you as a child to be like him/her?

To Start:

- 1. Let's review the memory verse Matthew 11:7-8
- 2. Let's briefly share some of our notes and/or reflections from this weekend's teaching on Matthew 12:15-21.

To Observe a little and think a little:

1. 1. Let's read verses 15 and 16 to talk about what most strikes us in terms of Jesus' treatment of the different groups of people mentioned.

- 2. What do verses 17 and 18 tell us about the identity of Jesus? Let's read them in several versions before sharing.
- 3. Is there something in the style of Jesus that resonates more strongly in your heart when reading verses 19.20? Let's read them and share our thoughts.
- 4. Let's finally read verse 21 and then each of us say it in words that a 3 year old child can understand.

Food for thought:

- 1. How does Jesus' treatment of all kinds of people inspire you to do the same?
- 2. Based on this passage, what would you say to someone who does not yet know Jesus?
- 3. What aspect of Jesus' style do you appreciate most at this time in your relationship with him?
- 4. Lets pray for our cities?
